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The Community Shul provides a warm, inviting environment for all Jews who have made the choice to adopt a rich, vibrant, Torah-based life, and for those just beginning this exciting journey.

It is with this in mind, and with much anticipation, that I would like to announce The Community Shul's new mutual collaboration with Rabbi Mordechai Teller. His organization, **JHubLa**, works with young professionals, ages 23-35, a group of individuals that can add so much to our Shul. His core mission parallels ours – to make Torah real and relevant – and he is as excited as we are to be joining forces for this exciting mission. Our collaboration this past year has already produced a co-sponsored Seder for 60 young singles and families... the first ever in our Shul! We also shared an all-night learning program on Shavuot for several hundred people!

In order to give **JHubLa** students a feeling of ownership in The Community Shul, we have created a new program called **J Membership**, to provide an opportunity for them to belong to our community, and enjoy the services and amenities we provide at a price they can afford.

This is just the start of this evolving relationship, and the sky's the limit!

In addition to this exciting partnership, we are moving full steam ahead with our various Shul classes and programs, including:

- Two steady morning, afternoon and evening minyanim.
- Numerous Shabbatons with scholars-in-residence (over the past year, these included R. Aryeh Sampson, R. Yaacov and Lori Palatnik, R. Noach Orlowek, R. Dovid and Shulamis Charlop, and R. Noach Light).
