We Answer to a Higher Authority

Bamidbar 17:3 "Aharon stood between the dead and the living."

Rashi: Aharon seized the angel of death to prevent him from continuing the plague.

The angel argued that he only listened to HaShem, whereas Aharon was only listening to Moshe. Aharon responded that Moshe only did what he was told to do by HaShem, and the angel was forced to accept Aharon's argument.

Rav Shach z'l explained that this demonstrates that a human being trumps an angel. This is due to the fact that we are on a higher level than the angels, because we have free will.

Life's Lesson: Free will trumps the will of an angel

Holy wrong

Bamidbar 17:6 "You killed the nation of HaShem."

Moshe Rabbeinu knew that the followers of Korach would die, just like Nadav and Avihu had died, if they were not supposed to bring the incense. But at the same time, the followers also knew that they were going to die. Why then were the people angry at Moshe and Aharon?

Rav Schwab z'l explained that the followers of Korach had a burning desire to serve HaShem, even if it meant sacrificing their lives. Hence, Korach's tent is called a mikdash and the pans called holy. The Jewish people thought that Moshe and Aharon had exploited a misguided and misdirected yet holy intention.

Life's lesson: Being holy does not mean being right
