Making Torah REAL and RELEVANT

Practical Halacha - Hoshana Rabbah

- This is the day that the final judgment gets sealed and sent out.
- Many have the minhag to read all of sefer Devarim at night.
- Many have the minhag to say entire sefer Tehilim.
- Many have the minhag to stay up the entire night.
- We say the shabbos pesukei dizimra. We say Mizmor Lisodah. When the Torah is taken out, we say what we normally say on Yom Tov.
- Many have the custom that the Chazan wears a kittel for Hoshanos and daven Musaf using the tune of Yomim Noraim.
- We take five extra aravos (at the minimum three should be taken) and hit them on the ground five times.
- The two aravos from the lulav can be removed and used.
- We try to make sure that some of the leaves fall off the aravos when hit.
- Women only say a small amount of the hoshanos and then hit the arovos.
- Some have the custom to place the aravos on top of the aron until Pesach and use them to bake matzos or to burn chometz
- Although the four minim don't have any kedusha after Yom Tov, it is still preferable to dispose of them in a respectful way. They can even be left if you know someone will come and dispose of them.
- Some save the lulav to burn in the fire for the matzos.
- Many have the custom to eat "hidden foods" called kreplach because it is a hidden Yom Tov because melacha can still be done.

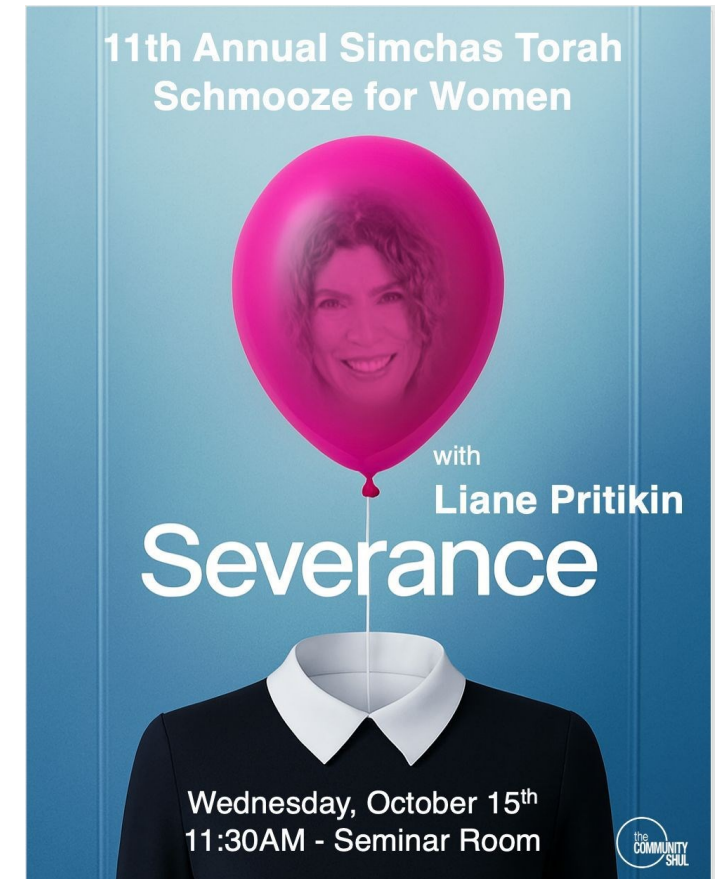
