Making Torah REAL and RELEVANT

Practical Halacha - Erev Pesach

- Shaving, haircuts, and cutting nails should be completed before chatzos; (Halachic midday)
- If you forgot to do these things, a gentile may do them for you;
- If a gentile is not available, you may do them yourself;
- No melacha (similar to Chol HaMoed) should be done after chatzos;
- The same leniences that permit melacha on Chol Hamoed apply on Erev Pesach after chatzos;
- A gentile may do melacha for you;
- Regular business is permitted;
- Laundry should not be done after chatzos, unless necessary for Yom Tov;
- Matzah is not allowed to be eaten starting from the evening of Erev Pesach;
