Making Torah REAL and RELEVANT

Practical Halacha - Birkas Levana (blessing of the new moon)

What? You do not need to see the moon completely clearly in order to say kiddush levana, but you must be able to see the outline of the moon. It should be visible from the beginning of the blessing until the end of the blessing.

Where? Kiddush levana should be done outside unless it is not clean or you are sick in which case you may recite the bracha in the house, looking at the moon through a window.

Who? You do not need a minyan to say kiddush levana. Women do not say kiddush levana. After a fast you should have something to eat before kiddush levana. However, following Yom Kippur we may do it immediately because we are full of joy from having our sins forgiven.

When? Motzei Shabbos is the preferred time since we are in a good mood and properly dressed. It is permitted to say it from the third day (three periods of 24 hours) after the molad until 14 days and 18 hours after the molad.


