Practical Halacha - The mitzvah of havdala

When filling the cup for havdala, you should fill it completely until a little runs over, as this is a sign of blessing. You should not cause it to overflow too much, as this would be wasteful.

You hold the cup in your right hand and the spices in his left hand. You continue to hold them like that until you recite the bracha of hagafen over the wine. You then switch the cup to the left hand and pick up the spices in your right hand to recite the bracha of besamim over the spices. (As a general rule, whatever you are reciting a bracha over should be in the right hand.)

Holding the cup in your right hand, you then recites the bracha over the candle. You then recite the bracha of hamavdil. (The cup is never placed down because all the brachos should be recited over a cup.)

You then sit and drink the whole cup (at least 3 ozs by yourself so that you can make a bracha achrona. There is a difference of opinion as to whether havdalah should be recited sitting or standing. In either case, you should drink while seated.

If you drink less than a cheekful, you do not fulfill your obligation. The small amount of wine that remains in the cup is poured out and the candle is doused in it. The practice is for women not to drink from the havdalah cup.

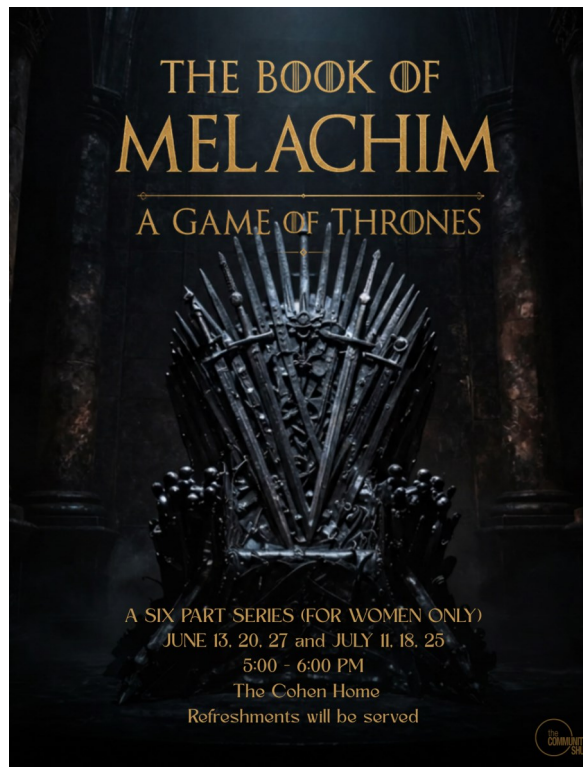
