PRACTICAL HALACHA

Tashlich

What?

Tashlich is a symbolic prayer which expresses a desire to rid oneself of past sins. The core liturgy of Tashlich is only a few verses from the book of Micha which extol God's thirteen attributes of mercy.

Where?

Tashlich should take place at a flowing, natural body of water that contains fish. It is also considered advantageous to perform Tashlich outside of the city, if possible. It is permitted to say Tashlich from a place where one can see a river, no matter how far away it is.

When?

Most people do Tashlich on the first day of Rosh HaShanah in the afternoon following Mincha, though some have the custom to do it before Mincha. It is best to do Tashlich before sunset, and certainly before nightfall. In some communities Tashlich is deferred to the second day of Rosh HaShanah when the first day of Rosh Hashana falls out on Shabbos. In other communities no such distinction is made and Tashlich is always recited on the first day of Rosh HaShanah even when it is a Shabbos. It may be said until Hoshana Rabba if one was unable to do so earlier.

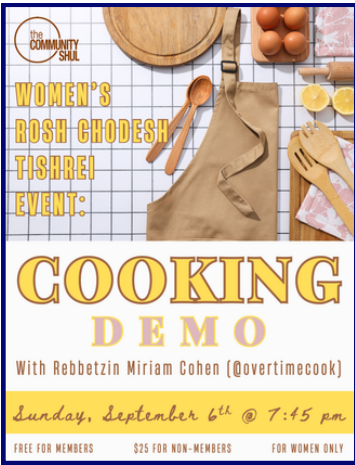
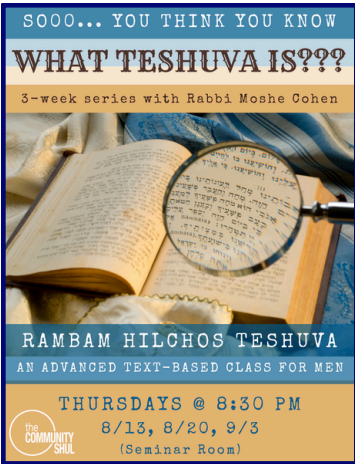
